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Attendance (including term time holidays)

At the beginning of a new school year, I would like to stress how important good attendance is. We understand that children are sometimes ill, and when they are ill you as parents are expected to keep them home and care for them, seek medical advice if appropriate, and communicate with us the reason for the absence either by phone call or email. If your child is ill often, or for an extended period, we will offer help by arranging a meeting to discuss or offer the school nurse's help. Our aim is that every child has the best chance to an education. The school does not authorise any absences caused by term time holidays. This means that absences caused by pupils taking holidays during term time will be recorded as unauthorised.

School uniform

Following the first meeting of the School Council this week, one of the points raised was that they would like to see more effort put into wearing a school uniform. It was estimated that around 75% of the children wore school uniform this week.

The School Council would like to remind you of the following:

- 1. School uniform helps with the sense of belonging and pride, makes choosing an outfit easier in the mornings, saves time and money, and avoids comparing fashionable outfits etc.*
- 2. Remember that our school uniform is only the top half (everyone is welcome to choose the bottom half e.g. trousers/shorts, skirt, trainers and so on)*
- 3. School uniforms are for sale at FFIGAR and Alison Jones*
- 4. Second-hand school uniforms are also for sale at the school*
- 5. You don't have to have the school logo - a plain red polo shirt/sweater is also acceptable*

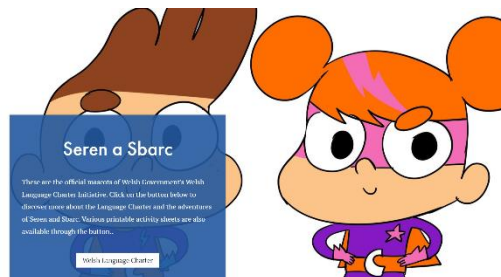
